## Good afternoon everyone,

The Department for Education are offering a pilot scheme to increase mobile data allowances for families of children and young people.

## Who can get help

This scheme is open to children and young people who:

- don't have access to a fixed broadband connection
- cannot afford the additional data needed to access educational resources or social care services
- have access to a mobile device that uses a participating network
- are facing disruption to their face-to-face education, or have been advised not to attend school

What information you'll need to collect

To request extra mobile data, you can send the following information to:

- the account holder's name
- their mobile number (a number beginning with '07')
- their mobile network
- whether they pay monthly or pay as they go
