SCARBOROUGH VISIT (Monday 11th July – Friday 15th July 2022)

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have started to finalise arrangements for our exciting Year 6 residential visit. We are busy making plans and are hoping that as circumstances improve we are able to go and enjoy this fantastic trip. We will be staying at Cober Hill in Cloughton, near Scarborough for an exciting week long residential.

Cober Hill opened as a guesthouse in 1920 and now acts as a centre for conferences, education visits and holidays. Cober Hill has an informal friendly environment, all the bedrooms are en-suite and the meals are provided by experienced catering staff in two dining rooms. The extensive grounds have games equipment and there is also an indoor games room.

The cost of this visit this year will be no more than **£250**. However, we will do our utmost to decrease the cost. As and when we find out the cost of activities, we will be able to give you a definitive cost. This trip represents great value for money as it covers the cost of transport for the week - both to, from and around the area we will be staying during the residential. It also includes the cost of accommodation which incorporates all food – a 3 course breakfast, a packed lunch for each day and a 3 course evening meal. The cost of this trip also includes a number of activities such as a visit to the Eden Camp, a steam train ride on the North Yorkshire Moors Railway, a visit to the National Railway Museum and a trip to the SeaLife Centre in Scarborough.

This is the last chance for the year group to enjoy time together before they all move to secondary school and this is a really important experience. It will provide a lasting memory of your child's time at primary school. In previous years, we have taken almost the entire year group and all the children have an amazing time.

Payments need to be paid in the usual way through school money. This has already been set up and payments can start being paid immediately.

To secure your child's place on this trip, **a deposit of £35 needs to reach us by Friday 15th October with the balance being paid by Friday 24th June.**

Should circumstances alter and we are not able to make the visit, then you will be entitled to a full refund.

Once your child's place is secure, you will be invited to an information afternoon, where the staff will run through the full week's itinerary, explaining to you what your children will need to bring and answer any questions you may have.
