



Year 4 Residential to Robinwood (5th – 7th January 2026)

Dear Parents and Carers,

After the fantastic success of our recent Year 4 residential, I am excited to let you know that we have secured a booking to visit Robinwood Activity Centre again next year. This trip will be open for children who will be in year 4 next year (our current year 3 children).



We will be staying at Dobroyd Castle. Dobroyd Castle is set high up on the Todmorden moors enjoying some fantastic views of the surrounding area. It is a historic, grade two listed building, with wonderful architecture including a breathtaking main entrance hall. The 17 acres of grounds, which accommodate Robinwood adventure and teamwork activities, are also the home for a wide range of wildlife including deer, rabbits and many more.

The trip is scheduled to take place from the **5th January 2026 to the 7th January 2026**. The cost of the trip, which includes all activities, food and accommodation, will be **no more than £225** per child. Robinwood is an excellent facility which provides waterproofs, fleeces and wellies for all children which will reduce the kit needed for the trip.

During their three days at Robinwood, the children will engage in a wide range of exciting and adventurous activities.

These activities are carefully designed to challenge and develop their physical and mental capabilities, fostering personal growth, as well as teamwork and perseverance.

Robinwood has an excellent reputation for providing a safe and secure environment for children, with highly trained staff ensuring the well-being and safety of all participants throughout the duration of the trip.

Participation in this trip is optional and we understand that it may not be feasible for all families. **If you are interested in having your child participate in this residential trip, please return the expression of interest slip which is attached to this letter and pay a £25 deposit on School Money (or in the office by bank card) by Friday 4th April 2025.** This will allow us to gauge parental interest, secure places and finalise costings.
